If a serious risk of criminal acts is suspected dial 999. All will be carefully considered and action taken as appropriate after taking professional advice as needed. Safeguarding events will be treated confidentially.

Accidents and injuries should be reported. Reporting forms are available in a folder in the kitchen or on the website. If a serious illness or injury dial 999. Seek trained medical advice as needed. All will be carefully considered and action taken as appropriate by the committee. Medical matters are treated confidentially.

Near misses should be reported. Anything that might have caused crime or injury or loss to the charity. Reporting forms are available in a folder in the kitchen or on the website. All will be carefully considered and action taken as appropriate by the committee.

Complaints can be made to any committee member or using the near miss procedures. All complaints will be carefully considered and action taken as appropriate by the committee.

Any other reports should be made using the near miss procedures. This includes but it not limited to bullying and harassment and any form of discrimination. Whistle blowing can be reported using this channel but you can report it to any committee member of your choice. It will be investigated and dealt with promptly and confidentially.
